### **Academic Eligibility [First Three Quarters of 2017-18 School Year]**

2. Students with failing grades may not be eligible to participate in the BRIDGE Program.

### **Attendance/Extracurricular Eligibility**

**To enroll and be eligible for the BRIDGE Program, you must meet the following guidelines:**

1. You may not have more than 5 combined tardies, dismissals, or absences in the third quarter. Family vacations are considered unexcused absences. Approved college visits are considered excused absences.
2. You may not be banned from participating in extracurricular activities for any disciplinary reason.
